APPALACHIAN IMPACT - Menifee County in Eastern Kentucky

In 22 of Kentucky's Appalachian counties, more than 10% of occupied housing units are in substandard condition. No running water or indoor plumbing... crumbling foundations... sagging roofs... The median income of this region averages 50% below the U.S. median income. For over 20 years, the EPC has developed a relationship within this community through the Appalachian Impact experience. For novices and veterans alike, Appalachian Impact has been a life changing and faith transforming experience. It is ideal as a level I or II trip for middle and high school students, or for mission trip veterans. It is primarily work project oriented through the renovation of homes for the elderly and needy. There are additional opportunities for children's VBS and community outreach activities, including a literacy program and thrift store located at Project Worth. Accommodations are at the Four Seasons Campground which features air conditioned cabins, a large in-ground swimming pool, chapel, hotel, and dining hall. Any student or leader who has participated on Appalachian Impact before knows full well why this is a very popular mission trip.

The Appalachian Impact trip is unique in that it avails churches the opportunity to plant a mission trip. The goal is to "plant" a trip each week until the summer is full of EPC churches doing God's transforming work. Churches can choose to partner with another church or lead their own week.

One partnership opportunity comes from Grace Chapel EPC of Farmington Hills, MI. They would like to invite another church to serve alongside them the first week of July. Their intent is to partner with a church or youth group that also feels called to eventually lead a mission's trip week in KY. The church or youth group would send a leadership team (comprised of adults or adults and teens) to travel with Grace to gain experience and to prepare to lead their own trip the following year.

BORDER TRANSITIONS MINISTRY, INC. - LAREDO, TEXAS / NUEVO LAREDO, MEXICO

Border Transitions Ministry exists to serve the spiritually, physically, and financially poor in Southern Texas and Northern Mexico border region. EPC home missionaries, John & Diane Davis (First EPC in Laredo) invite you to Laredo, TX to serve the poor through food ministry, construction projects, VBS, sports camp, adult education, and medical care. They can tailor your trip according to your group's skills and needs. Translators are provided, if needed. This is a level II or III mission opportunity that is customizable for small to mid-size groups to serve alongside a church that loves and serves on the front lines in poor *colonias* within the Laredo region. Currently no groups will be traveling to Nuevo Laredo, MX. However, there are numerous needs and ministry opportunities to serve the poor in Texas!

THE WADE CENTER - BLUEFIELD, WEST VIRGINIA

The Wade Center was founded by an EPC Pastor and is a year-round outreach/ministry to at-risk children and youth. Every summer, the Wade Center provides a complete Urban-Appalachian project experience that is virtually effortless for church youth leaders – they take care of everything! The Wade Center provides the meals, housing, construction materials, programs, oversight, and spiritual growth opportunities. They also offer an "Adventure Day" where your youth will be able to experience more of the West Virginia frontier through activities, such as: white water rafting, zip lining and completing a ropes course. Your youth will finish the day by playing on Adventure Lake. This is an excellent level I or II experience for high school and mature middle school students. The week includes construction, home renovation, summer camp, tutoring, mentoring, VBS and sports outreach. They can customize your trip according to your needs. The cost is \$350 per person for 6 days, or \$325 if registered prior to Feb 18th. The summer dates available are from June 11 – August 6. The camp runs from Saturday evening (6pm) thru Friday morning (10 am). Early spring dates and winter ski weekends are also available. Previous trips have included construction, VBS type youth programs, prayer walks, evangelistic outreaches, drama, sports and more. It lies on the fringe of the third largest gambling region in the U.S., after Las Vegas and Atlantic City. The cost is \$250 per participant which includes room, board and construction materials.

JAMAICA MISSIONS - Mandeville, Jamaica

Mission trips to Jamaica offer a wide variety of level III ministry opportunities. Past undertakings by many EPC churches have included construction projects and ministry to local residents. Teams have painted, repaired roofs, poured concrete for churches and homes. They have visited orphanages, local schools, and state-run hospitals. This is all done with the ultimate goal of tangibly sharing the love of Christ to those in need. The team stays at Bethel Christian Retreat in Mandeville. This is situated in the beautiful mountains of central Jamaica. The cabins are clean, but there is no hot water for showers. There are accommodations for meetings and dining. For a 7-10 day stay, the fee for the camp may vary, so call for more information.
